The State of Wisconsin, having appeared by Attorneys Kenneth Kratz, Thomas Fallon and Norm Gahn, Manitowoc County Special Prosecutors, and the defendant, having appeared personally, and by counsel, Attorneys Dean Strang and Jerome Buting;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that for reasons articulated on the record on February 2, 2007:

1. The vial of blood currently under seal in the Manitowoc County Clerk of Court's Office be unsealed and made available to representatives of the Calumet County Sheriff's Department to conduct scientific and forensic testing, including fingerprinting. The State may determine the order of all testing.

2. That the State will preserve sufficient sample from the blood vial and stains recovered from the RAV 4 for the defendant, should he pursue independent testing.
