ORDER REGARDING VENUE AND TRIAL SCHEDULE

The parties having presented the Court with a stipulation regarding venue and trial schedule in which the parties jointly request that the case be tried before a jury composed of Manitowoc County residents, but that the place of trial be changed from the Manitowoc County Courthouse to the Calumet County Courthouse; and

The defendant having personally waived on the record his right to be tried in Manitowoc County and expressed in writing his preference that the case be tried in Calumet County [Oborn v. State, 143 Wis. 249, 258 (1910)]; and


The Court having determined that in addition to the joint request of the parties, considerations involving courthouse security, media and public accessibility, and economics will be served by changing the place of trial as requested by the parties,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the trial in this action shall commence with jury selection on February 5, 2007. Following selection of a jury composed of Manitowoc County residents in the Manitowoc County courthouse, the trial shall be held at the Calumet County courthouse.
